- \* We try to ensure all groups are evenly matched although sometimes it's not always possible, please be patient and supportive of others
- \* Members are encouraged to be polite and thank the instructor for their time

Our events are extremely popular and get booked up quickly so please book your place well in advance.

Cancellation – should you need to cancel, please inform the event organiser as soon as possible. Where a member cancels their place and we are unable to fill it you will be expected to pay for the lesson/event.

#### **Turn Out**

Please ensure you are turned out correctly with our Branch jumper/polo shirt/t-shirt and where applicable Pony Club tie, badge (appropriate felt). Plain preferably light coloured (beige) jodhpurs, riding boots and hair tied back. Your horse/pony should be clean with correctly fitting tack

Your riding hat must be checked and tagged before taking part in any mounted rallies.

Jockey skull caps and back protector are compulsory when jumping cross country.
